***Age:**

The course is open to all ages above 18. The course mentors themselves range in age from 30 to 65, age will not be a factor of selection. Please consider that given the environmental challenges, a good level of physical and emotional fitness is however conducive to participating fully in the workshop.

Language:

Please note that all coursework and daily communication will mainly be held in English. Spanish is not necessarily required, although it will

be useful to get around by yourself or with a local guide. Some of the discourses will be held in Spanish and translated by the team.

Fitness:

Please note that the local conditions and intensity of the workshop programme require a good level of physical and emotional fitness to fully benefit from the workshop. We need to balance group logistics with individual needs. Due to the environmental realities of the rainforest and river transport system not all physical disabilities can be accommodated.

Tuition fee / payments:

The tuition fee is € 5000.- total. It has to be paid in two instalments (see dates above).
Selected participants will be notified by email on the 6th of April 2020 and will be provided with detailed instructions on the payment process.

Selection process:

Applications do not guarantee a spot in the workshop, participants will be selected by the team and notified by email on the 6th of April 2020. The final selection cannot be appealed. Depending on the applications received there will be a waiting list. If a selected participant has not paid their tuition fee by the deadline, their place will automatically pass to the next applicant on the waiting list.

Cancellation / refunds:

There will be no refunds of amounts paid at any point in time, so we highly recommend trip interruption or cancellation insurance.

Insurance:

Artists need to provide all of their own insurance for liability, health, covering, but not limited to art supplies, equipment, personal items, reliable transportation to Iquitos. All responsibility regarding personal medical supplies and health insurance lie with the participant. Once selected, we recommend to get health and travel insurance from worldnomads.com for the period spent in Peru. Real Lives will not provide any insurance for any part of the workshop program.

Privacy:

The use of your data is limited to the selection process and the organisation of the workshop. Any information supplied in the application form will be used solely for the purposes of this workshop and archived after the completion. You will not

receive any contact from Real Lives or its partners except with regard to this workshop and your application.

Visa:

Please check with the embassy of your country of residence/ citizenship and allow sufficient time to arrange one, if necessary. Any occurring costs related to visa applications are to be covered by the applicants themselves. Failure to secure a visa will not be grounds for a refund, so please check with your embassy.

General:

Artists should be self-sufficient, independent and enjoy working in a public, culturally sacred environment. All participants have to be able to commit to the full workshop term. The participants must comply with all regulations at the Allpahuayo Mishana Reserve while being accommodated there and other locations visited as part of the workshop program.

The workshop program may be canceled or interrupted due to a government shutdown, artist non participation, or during any hazardous weather conditions, including, but not limited to, fire danger, environmental concerns, or any unforeseen circumstances, natural or otherwise, to which Real Lives and any affiliates will NOT be held accountable or responsible, no refunds will be issued.

All terms are subject to change, in which case the participants will be informed. Confirmed participants may be required to accept further conditions, contracts and agreements including but not limited to; codes of conduct, rules and regulations, housing agreements.

Once selected, we recommend to get travel health and travel interruption / cancellation insurance from worldnomads.com or similar providers for the period spent in Peru.
